HOW IT WORKS?



- Fill in the request Form
- Details your availabilities, contact point in Belgium, as well as your interests
- Choose a language
- The Greeter Network will look for a available volunteer
- And will put you into contact

DOING A GREET IS



- Free of charge
- Less than 6 participants
- Every day from 8 am to 10 pm
- A genuine encounter and off the beaten path
- Favour of soft mobility (public transportation, by foot or by bike)
- A program elaborated by both the visitor and the Greeter

SOME NUMBERS



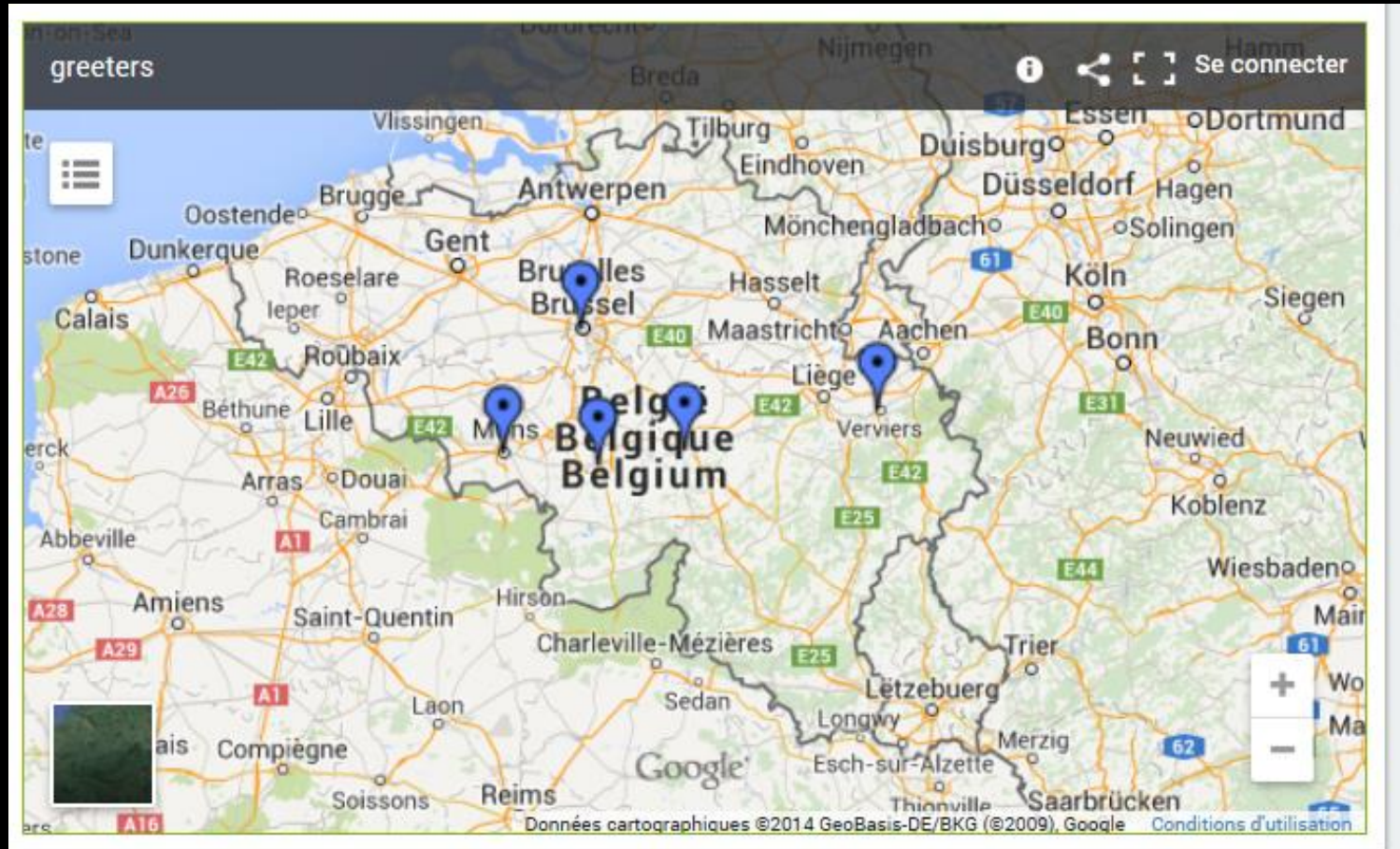
- 100 volunteers
- Speaking 7 languages
- Available during the week or weekends
- From every average of age with a bit more of 40 +
- Welcomed 1.600 visitors (in 2013)
- Most visitors come from France (34 %), Belgium (22 %) and USA (11 %) (40 different nationalities)
